2016 TRILOGY CHALLENGE TOURNAMENT

Dear Registrant:

Thank you for registering for the **Trilogy Challenge** at the beautiful 18-hole Beacon Hill Park Disc Golf Course.

The course features a wide open front nine in a park setting and a very challenging "Outback Nine." Both red and blue tee options are available throughout the course and offers incredible views of Utah Valley, Utah Lake, and the Rocky Mountains that surround the cities of Highland and Alpine. The course features large expanses of open grass, natural fields, established scrub oak forests, and bluffs overlooking a (usually) dry creek, all perfect for hucking discs into well placed baskets.

The Trilogy Challenge is your chance to prove your skill with a level playing field in regards to discs. Players are only allowed to play in the tournament with the three 2016 discs they receive in their player pack; if a disc is lost during the round, they must finish the round without it. Players get everything they need to play disc golf for only \$30!

- Closest to the Pin (Blue Tees Only) - Holes 3, 6, 8, 11, 17
- Closest to the Pin (Red Tees Only) - Holes 11, 12, 16, 17

FORMAT/UNIQUE RULES:

Standard 18 hole round, playing Blue or Red Tees, with lowest score winning.

Out of Bounds "OB"

- The out of bounds "OB" areas are the houses and property lines that surround the park, Beacon Hill Blvd., and the parking lot. The disc is considered OB only if it is completely surrounded by the OB area.
- Player receives one (1) penalty throw.
- Player elects to throw next shot from the previous lie or up to one meter away from and perpendicular to the point where the disc last crossed into out of bounds (even if it's closer to the hole).

Unplayable Lie

- Player may relocate to a new lie that is no closer to the hole and within five meters of the unplayable lie, or go back to the previous lie.
- Player receives one (1) penalty throw.

Disc in a Tree/Bush

- Discs may be played from bushes, they do not have to be on the ground. No penalty.
- Player may shake the tree (regardless of height) or throw an object at disc to dislodge it, and play the disc where ever it lies with no penalty. If disc is still irretrievable, follow "Unplayable Lie" rule.

Mandatory Rule "Mando"

- Holes 3 and 4 require mandatory requirements from blue tee box.

- Player receives one (1) penalty throw and plays disc from sign.

CHECK IN:

Locate the small tent near the parking lot to check in. The flexible start means you can come when you want, but last tee off is at 6:00 p.m. Allow two hours to play 18 holes. We reserve the right to not start your play at Hole 1 if the course gets too crowded.

The Short Game Facility provides 27 stations to practice your short game skills.

FACILITIES:

There will be a port-a-potty in parking lot. Grocery stores are about two miles away.

WHAT ARE WE DOING WITH THE PROFIT?

Any profit from this event will go to the maintenance and upgrading of the course.
