

History of Highland

Highland was settled by homesteaders in the 1870s. Some of the first settlers to the area chose the name, Highland, because it reminded them of the beautiful Highlands of Scotland. Highland is located at the mouth of American Fork Canyon and sits on a high plateau at the base of Mt. Timpanogos. Each year the Highland Fling Days is held to commemorate the beginning of Highland with a parade, fireworks and a week-long celebration.

Highland is known as the gateway to the American Fork Canyon. From Highland you can access the Timpanogos Cave National Monument and the Alpine Scenic Loop. Within Highland's 8.5 incorporated square miles are a 26 mile trail system which ties in to the Bonneville Shoreline Trail and the Murdock Canal Trail systems.

Grand Marshals Lloyd & Rebecca Hansen

Highland City has chosen Lloyd and Rebecca Hansen as the Grand Marshals for the 2013 Highland Fling. Between them they have five children and twelve grandchildren. Lloyd retired three years ago as Director of Operations for Highland City, having served the City for 14 years. Prior to working for Highland City he was employed by Signetics Corporation for 15 years. He has many hobbies and talents, which includes metal works and restoring old cars.



Lloyd began his career with Highland City as one of two individuals hired full time to help the growing public works department. He experienced going from broadcasting salt for snowy streets from the back of a pick-up truck to assisting with the City's first purchase of a one ton truck with a snow plow. He began housing public works equipment in his personal garage to overseeing a fleet of equipment which is now housed in the City's public works building

Initially Lloyd worked full time as a snow plow driver during the winter months, but progressed to lead man, superintendent, and finally Director of Operations. As the City grew, he was instrumental in receiving approvals to hire additional staff. He worked with the engineers and contractors on planning and construction of the pressurized irrigation system, and design of the City Cemetery; coordinated the construction of the fence and planting of the trees in the cemetery; and became the first City Cemetery Sexton. He started the Arbor Day plantings and community tree sales, organized the first Shade Tree Committee, helped get the first Arbor Day Charter and Proclamation, and saw Highland City receive the designation of Tree City USA. Later it became Lloyd's responsibility to oversee and inspect the work of contractors who did work for the City. As the City grew, Lloyd worked with the Public Works Director and Engineer and department heads to accomplish what was necessary and best for the City's public works.

When asked what the City meant to Lloyd he said, "Nowhere else in Utah is there a better place than Highland, not a better city staff, and certainly not a better Public Works Department crew and staff. This City is filled with so many wonderful people who are respectful of the City and where they live. I could not live anywhere else."

Highland City gratefully acknowledges the many years of dedicated service and the imprint Lloyd has made through his years of service helping oversee the public works needs of this growing city.


