

NOTICE OF HIGHLAND PLANNING COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING

The Highland Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on May 24th, 2022 at 7:00 pm, or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Highland City Council Chambers, 5400 West Civic Center Dr, Highland, UT. The Planning Commission will receive public comments concerning the following:

- Highland City Staff is proposing to amend the following sections of the Development Code:
 - Section 3-4103 Area and Width Requirements to address the discrepancy between rounding up and rounding down when determining the number of allowable lots in residential zones.
 - Section 3-614 to allow a home occupation in every residential unit.
 - Chapter 5 Subdivisions to require that remnant parcels have a plan as part of the preliminary plat approval of a subdivision.
 - Article 5-10 Adjusting Property Boundaries; Amending a Recorded Plat to simplify the approval process for the combining of lots or parcels.
 - Section 3-612 Fences, Retaining Walls, Theme and Screen Walls to add an exception to the retaining wall maximum for daylight basements and window wells.
 - Sections 3-4104, 3-4204, and 3-4254 Location Requirements to add setback regulations for cantilevers, bay windows, stairs, and fireplace chases.
